Dr. Vijay Prakash Mathur
Professor and Head, AIIMS, New Delhi

Dr. Vijay Prakash Mathur is currently Professor and Head of Division of Pedodontics and Preventive Dentistry at AIIMS, New Delhi. He is also a Member Secretary for Institute Ethics Sub committee for Monitoring of Clinical Trials. He has been part of about 30 projects funded by different organizations. He has been awarded with Common wealth Academic Fellowship in 2014. He is one of the few dental professional who has been trained in qualitative research, clinical research and epidemiology. He has been contributing for WHO, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India and other organizations for the profession.

Prof. Saranjit Singh Bhasin
Dean, Jamia Millia Islamia

Prof. Saranjit Singh Bhasin is presently the Dean and also heads the Department of Prosthodontics at the Faculty of Dentistry at Jamia Millia Islamia, a Central University at New Delhi. His area of interest is metallic biomaterials and has been associated with research work involving Dental Implants at Institute of Medical Sciences, BHU and Institute of Nuclear Medicine & Allied Sciences (INMAS).
